Contest to design Phila. police, firefighters memorial is on

A design competition is set to start today for a new memorial that will honor Philadelphia firefighters and police officers who have died in the line of duty.

The city currently has the "Living Flame Memorial" and sculpture, which was designed and created with recycled materials by **Reginald E. Beauchamp** and honors fallen police and firefighters. That memorial, which sits in Franklin Square, was dedicated in 1976 and would be replaced with the new design.

A group consisting of the Philadelphia Fire Fighters Union Local 22, the Philadelphia Fraternal Order of Police Lodge No. 5 Memorial Fund and **Historic Philadelphia Inc.** are spearheading the effort and the Philadelphia chapter of the **American Institute of Architects** and **Anthony Bracali** of Friday Architects is serving as competition adviser. The competition will help determine how much should be budgeted for the new memorial along with subsequent fundraising efforts. Councilman **Jim Kenney** is serving as fund trustee.

The deadline for entries is Nov. 1 and the winner will be notified by mid-November.
